The children have been encouraged to look more closely at some of St. Matthew's readings, to see what God is telling us, and to interpret them through artwork.




St. Benedict Class

St. Bernadette Class "Follow me and I will make you fishers of men" Ch 4 v 18-22




St. Cecilia Class "Listen, anyone who has ears!" Ch 13 v4- 9
