Children's 'Stay Safe' Policy

All children have rights

All children have rights, no matter who they are, what they look like or if they are a boy or a girl.

So you have rights too!



All adults working in our school do what is best for children

We listen to children and take them seriously.

We help children to stay safe.

We help your parents and carers to look after you.

People should never hurt children

Adults who work at school will always do their best to protect children from any harm or abuse such as being hit, being neglected or being made to do things or see things that make you feel uncomfortable. Remember the **PANTS** rule.

It's not your fault if someone hurts you

If someone hurts you or if someone hurts another child, then you can tell any adult who works in school. You can tell your **teachers** in class, supervisors at playtime or **Suzanne**, our school counsellor. The adult will listen to you and decide what to do to help you.
