Year 1 Learning for the week beginning 26th September 2022

<u>SCIENCE</u>: Our learning challenge question will be: What material is best for Jack's coat and why? The children will be designing their very own coat for when Jack is in the clouds, choosing the most appropriate material.

R.E: We will be learning about the life of Jesus as a child.

ENGLISH: We will be reading the story of Jack and the Beanstalk. The sounds for the coming week are: ar, or and air. Please use the sound cards to practise these and all sounds learnt so far this term. We have sent home a reading sheet to help you practise sounding out words with these sounds with your child. When they are confident with reading the words, please practise spelling them too. The children will also practise spelling the common exception words me, be, he, we, said.

READING AT HOME: Your child will read with an adult once per week and will have their books changed. A RWI book matching the child's reading level, an Oxford Reading Tree book and a book of their choice will be sent home along with a book of their choice for shared reading. Please read with and listen to your child read daily and comment in their reading records. Please use the questions at the back of the RWI book to support and check your child's understanding of the text they are reading.

<u>Maths:</u> The children will be learning about Time in maths this week. The children will also continue to practise number facts which make 10: 9+1 8+2 7+3 6+4 5+5

<u>SRE:</u> Over the next few weeks, we will be covering the Year 1 unit Let the Children Come as part of Relationship and Sex Education (RSE). The emphasis in Year 1 is on God's love for us. The aims of our unit are:

- We are created individually by God
- God wants us to talk to Him often through the day and treat Him as our best friend
- God has created us, His children, to know, love and serve Him
- We are created as a unity of body, mind and spirit: who we are matters and what we do matters
- We can give thanks to God in different way
