

Year 1 Learning for the week beginning 12th September 2022

Dear parents and carers,

Welcome back!

Each half term in Year 1 we base our learning around a Big Learning Challenge theme. This half term our Big Question is 'Who lives in a place like this?' The children will explore a variety of settings for traditional stories and fairy tales. This is a science based topic, where we will learn about the materials used to build the homes of the story characters we explore.

Science The children will learn about the signs of autumn.

R.E. The theme in R.E. is 'Families'. We would be grateful if the children could take in a picture of their family for our lesson discussion.

English In Year 1 we learn/ review 3 sounds each week. Next week we will begin to review Set 2 sounds.

ay (may I play?), ee (what can you see?) and igh (fly high).

Maths The children will be learning and developing CLIC skills.

The children are also practising their mental addition and are learning the facts:

1+1=2 2+2=4 3+3=6 4+4=8 5+5=10

The children must be able to recall these number facts out of sequence and without counting up on their fingers.

We will also be doing Place Value within 10. We will be sorting and counting objects.

PE Children will have PE sessions on Thursday/Fridays . Please ensure PE bags are in school on Monday. Children should wear plain white T shirt, black shorts and plimsols. No trainers please.

Hair accessories and earrings

All hair bands, bobbles, slides etc. must be **plain** and in **school colours**. Please note that this means **no patterns** (e.g. stripes/ spots etc.) and **no adornments** (e.g. bows/ flowers/ heart).

Earrings- children are **only** permitted to wear plain gold or silver stud earrings to school.
