Next Week's Curriculum:

ENGLISH: Next week, we will continue to read our book linked to our Science topic Stone girl bone girl by Laurence Anholt.

Reading focus: Retrieval of key facts

Writing focus: Narrative with a story mountain

Grammar focus: Writing in the past tense and using conjunctions

Spelling focus: Adding suffixes to words

MATHS: Next week we will be revisiting our learning on 2D and 3D shape. We will also continue to practise topics covered in CLIC 10.

SCIENCE TOPIC: What do rocks tell us about how the earth was formed?

Next week we will be investigating different properties of rock and how to test them.

R.E TOPIC: Homes

Next week we will be learning how the Holy family; Mary, Joseph and Jesus give us an example of a happy and caring family.

P.E TOPIC: Fitness

Next week we will be working on developing speed and strength through a range of exercises.

GEOGRAPY TOPIC: What makes the earth angry?

Next week we will be learning about how volcanoes are formed.

PSHE: Next week we will continue our TEN TEN topic called 'Get Up!'

Using the story of Jairus' daughter in different ways the children will learn that they are created by God out of love and for love: they were designed for this purpose, which should inform how they live.

FRENCH:
