

Year 1 Learning for the week beginning 17th October 2022

Dear parents and carers,

Science: This week in science, the children will be looking back at everything they have learnt this term. They will be designing their very own houses, labelling all the different materials they have used.

R.E. The children will be learning about Judaism this week. We will be focusing on the story of Abraham.

English The sounds for the coming week are: i-e (nice, smile) o-e (phone, home) and u-e (huge, brute). We have attached a reading sheet to help you practise sounding out words with these sounds with your child. When they are confident with reading the words, please practise spelling them too. We have included some common exception words (red words from Read, Write Inc) on the reading sheet. The children will also be writing about what takes place during baptism.

Maths -In Maths this week we will be going over CLIC 3 and preparing the children for CLIC 4 which we will start next term. We will also be continuing to work on addition skills.

Home Learning for the week

- Words for home reading sheet
- Learn Its number facts $1+9=10$ $2+8=10$ $3+7=10$ $4+6=10$
- Practise number and letter formation
- Counting in 5s up to 50

Please note that these are prerequisite skills that the children need to be fluent in in order to progress in their maths.

Multicultural Week- This week we will be celebrating different cultures. Each class will be focusing on a different country selected from those participating in this years Football World Cup. In year 1 we will be focusing on our countries flag, identifying the continent and hemisphere that that country is in, finding the country on a map, the capital city and the national dress.

St Joseph will be looking at Wales and St Elizabeth will be looking at Ghana.
