Next Week's Curriculum:

ENGLISH: Next week, we will be reading information texts about earthquakes linked to our geography topic

Reading focus: Retrieval of key facts

Writing focus: to write an information text using headings and sub-headings.

Grammar focus: Using conjunctions

Spelling focus: Adding suffixes to words

MATHS: Next week we will be practising column subtraction where they need to exchange or borrow.

SCIENCE TOPIC: What do rocks tell us about how the earth was formed?

Next week we will be using an investigation to identify soil types.

R.E TOPIC: Promises

Next week we will begin our new R.E topic. We will be learning about the sacrament of Baptism.

GEOGRAPHY TOPIC: What makes the earth angry?

FRENCH:

The children will practise greetings and simple phrases using a story.

P.E TOPIC: Fitness

Next week we will be working on developing speed and strength through a range of exercises.

RSHE: Next week we will continue our TEN TEN topic called 'Get Up!'

We will be looking at how personal and communal prayer and worship are necessary ways of growing in our relationship with God.

READING: Your child has been provided with a reading book and their reading journals have been returned to them. Please make a note of the date, book title, pages read and comment briefly on how well they have read to you. You could note how fluent their reading was, if they are enjoying it and any words you have helped them read or understand. Your child should be reading at least 20 MINS PER DAY.

SPELLING: You will find this week's spellings below and five year 2 common exception words. Please practise these with your child. They may like to use them in sentences to help them to learn the spellings. They may use their pink books for this.

We will test them on these spellings when we return on Monday. You will notice the last 4 weeks of spellings included below. We also test the children on 10 random spellings from across the 4 weeks (set 1).
