Admissions Policy

- Maximum of 60 places
- Statutory duty to give <u>priority</u> to Catholic children

(this does not mean we only accept Catholic children)

Governing body is the admissions authority

Oversubscription criteria

Our admissions policy prioritises baptised children from practising Catholic families. However:

- Our school is inclusive and welcomes applications from children of other faiths or no faith.
- We have a thriving diverse school community with children and staff from different cultures and religions
- Please read the school's admissions policy carefully

Tie Breaks

Where the offer of places to all the applicants in any of the categories listed above would lead to oversubscription, the following provisions will be applied:

The Governing Body may increase the priority of an application within a category where evidence is provided at the time of application of a compassionate need of the child, which the Governing Body considers to be exceptional, and which can be most appropriately met by this school.

(Please see "Definitions")

Whenever the situation arises where there are more applicants who satisfy the admissions criteria to the same degree than unallocated places, then the distance of the family's home from the school's main entrance, Becket Close, will be taken into consideration. The distance will be measured in a straight line from the child's home address to the designated entrance(s) of the school using a computerised measuring system (GIS) and geographical reference points as provided by the National Land and Property Gazetteer (NLPG). Those living closer to the school will receive higher priority.

Children of multiple births

The Admissions Code allows admissions authorities, where it is deemed appropriate, to exceed the statutory limit on infant class sizes of 30 if this is to admit all children of a multiple birth.

You can apply for up to six primary schools, including schools located outside Croydon.

Make sure that you list them in your order of preference.

Limiting the number of schools you apply for will not increase your chances of securing an offer of a place at your first preference school.

Catholic Schools require you to complete a Supplementary Information Form

 Must also complete the school's supplementary information form

 The SIFs seek information which is not collected on the online application but which is needed by the school to enable governors to reach a decision on your application.


 Supplementary Information Form and supporting documentation to be returned to St Thomas Becket School by 15th January 2023

How applications are dealt with

- The Council manages the process to ensure each applicant receives no one more than one offer of a Croydon school
- Details of applications received by the Council are passed to the school
- The school decides whether a place can be offered (in accordance with the admissions policy)
- Applications are ranked in 'offer' order by the school
- The school sends the list to the Council
- The Council identifies children in a position to be offered a place at more than one school
- The Council offers a place at the highest ranked school for which a successful application has been made



Allow plenty of time to complete applications and return them and all required documentation by the specified deadlines.

By 2 May 2023
