## Next Week's Curriculum:

**ENGLISH:** we will be starting our new book set in the stone age called, *One Small Blue Bead*.

**Reading focus:** Reading comprehension

**Writing focus:** to use persuasion

**Grammar focus:** conjunctions for reasons

**Spelling focus:** prefixes, in, dis and mis.

**MATHS:** We will be learning about measuring mass in grams and kilograms.

### P.E TOPIC: Invasion games

Next term we will be learning rules, skills and strategies to play tag rugby.

When the weather is not suitable we will be following our GETSET4PE Yoga programme. The children really enjoyed it. Ask them to teach you how to do it.
