

Year 1 Learning for the week beginning 21st November 2022

Dear parents and carers,

Infant Nativity Play: For the next two weeks we will be practising for the Nativity play. During this period, much of our time will be devoted to rehearsing. Please note that the children will have their reading books changed each week, but may not read with an adult in school as regularly. Please be patient during this period and continue to read at home.

Computing Week: Next week is computing week! The children will be learning to use Scratch Jr to code a story.

R.E: The children we be learning about a Christmas tradition. St Joseph will be focusing on carol services and St Elizabeth will be focusing on Christingles.

English: We will have no new sounds for the next 2 weeks, but please continue to practise the phonics cards and previous reading sheets sent home this term.

Maths: The children will continue to focus on addition to 10. They will also be focusing on CLIC 4.

We will also focus on counting back from 20. Ensure that your child is saying all the teen numbers correctly when counting as many children are saying the -ty numbers instead e.g. 20, 90,80,70 etc instead of 20, 19, 18, 17.

Please continue to practise Learn It number facts, recalling pairs of numbers which make 10 by heart (without counting on fingers). Some children are finding it challenging to remember the pairs of numbers.
