Next Week's Curriculum:

ENGLISH: we will be continuing to read Ug - Boy Genius of the Stoneage linked with our new history topic.

Reading focus: Reading comprehension

Writing focus: to retell an event in the story

Grammar focus: using speech marks

Spelling focus: 'ou', and 'y' in words

MATHS: We will continue to learn how to measure length using millimetres, centimetres and metres. We will also learn how to measure the perimeter of an object.

SCIENCE TOPIC: What do rocks tell us about how the earth was formed?

We will be learning about fossils and how they are formed.

R.E TOPIC: Promises

We will be learning about what commitments and promises made during baptism.

P.E TOPIC: Invasion games

Next term we will be learning rules, skills and strategies to play tag rugby.
