## Next Week's Curriculum:

**ENGLISH:** we will be reading a new class book, *The King who banned the dark*.

**Grammar focus:** using past tense to sequence the retelling of events.

**Spelling focus:** Suffix ly for adverbs in our writing.

**P.E TOPIC: Invasion games**

**MATHS:** We will be solving worded problems using column addition and/ or column subtraction.
