The Learning Challenge Big Question this half term is 'How have toys changed since my grandparents were 5?'

R.E. The children will continue our Lent topic. During the season of Lent the children will take turns bringing home Our Lenten Prayer Book for **one night** so that you can write a prayer as a family. Please return the book the following day so the children can share the prayer with the class.

History The question for this week is 'How have toys changed over time?'

Art The children will explore a variety of simple printing techniques.

Computing The children will learn about algorithms when programming a Beebot.

English We will review the sounds are/air. We will learning about nouns this week. The children will continue to explore themes from the book 'Look up!' by Nathan Bryon.

Maths We will be learning about place value within 50. We are will be identifying the tens and one within 50, for example 35 has 3 tens and 5 ones.

Please continue to practise the new Learn Its at home adding 2 or 3 to numbers to 10. The children should be encouraged to use quick recall without their fingers.
