Next Week's Curriculum:

ENGLISH: We will be starting to read *The Captive Celt* by Terry Deary.

Reading focus: To retrieve key facts from the text.

Grammar focus: Using direct speech.

Writing focus: Writing a narrative.

Spelling focus: To spell words with the suffixes -tion and -ssion (e.g. station, permission)

MATHS: We will be covering all areas of arithmetic, shape, space, measure and reasoning as part of our end of term assessments.

FRENCH: This term, the children will be taught by Madame Severine alongside their class teacher. The focus will be on learning their numbers and naming extended family members.
