

Attention Building Activities

Online Workshop



The Croydon Speech and Language Therapy Primary team are providing a range of online workshops for all staff working with children in Croydon schools.

Attention building activities (e.g. 'Attention Autism') are being used more and more in mainstream schools to support a skill that underlies the development of communication – the ability to share an experience with others.

Adults use fun, motivating activities to capture the children's attention. The aim is for the child to be able to respond as part of a group. First, the children just watch and respond. As the group progresses, the children are able to become more involved in what is happening.

- Attendees will get support with implementing attention building activities in their settings.
- The workshop will offer an overview of the approach, and give you the information you need to start delivering the sessions.
- There will be suggestions for toys, activities and games that will capture your children's attention.
- You will have the opportunity to talk to other school staff who are implementing the approach, and to share ideas with them.

The workshop will last around 50 minutes.
