

Colourful Semantics

Online Workshop

The Croydon Speech and Language Therapy Primary team are providing a range of online workshops for all staff working with children in Croydon schools.

'Colourful Semantics' is a system that supports children to develop their vocabulary and phrase structure, using simple 'action pictures', alongside colour-coded symbols. The child constructs a phrase by placing the symbols into a colour-coded frame, and then 'reads back' the whole phrase. There is an emerging evidence-base for this approach, it is easy to implement, and achievable for most children, with the right kind of material and prompting.



The workshop is for adults who are working with children who need a boost to their vocabulary and phrase structure.



You will learn about the rationale behind the approach, how to pick the right level of difficulty, where to find good resources, how to make your own, how to prompt children, and how to integrate Colourful Semantics with other motivating activities.



The workshop will take place online, and it will last around 50 minutes.
