

Blank Levels – Developing Verbal Reasoning

Online Workshop



The Croydon Speech and Language Therapy Primary team are providing a range of online workshops for all staff working with children in Croydon schools.

The aim of the 'Blank Levels of Questioning' approach is to develop children's verbal reasoning and their abstract language capabilities.

Attendees of the workshop will be encouraged to think about the types of questions that we ask in the classroom, ranging from basic questions that ask for simple and concrete responses, to more complex questions that require abstract answers.

- You will come out of the workshop with an understanding of how abstract language capabilities develop in primary age children.
- You will become more confident in your ability to find the right level of questioning to develop a child's reasoning.
- You will become aware of a range of published resources that can support children's development in this area.

The workshop will last around 50 minutes.
