

Sequencing and Narrative Skills

Online Workshop

The Croydon Speech and Language Therapy Primary team are providing a range of online workshops for all staff working with children in Croydon schools.

Oral narrative is the means by which people organize and make sense of the events in their lives. Children need to do it very often, for example when they:

- Tell a parent about what happened at school
- Tell a teacher what they did at the weekend
- Retell a story from a video they watched
- Tell a joke
- Relate what happened in an experiment
- Make a plan about future events
- Come up with a story.



The aim of the workshop is to help attendees understand why these skills are important, how they develop, and what you can do to support them. A range of resources will be discussed, and some recommended.

The workshop will last around 50 minutes.
