Part-closure of St Thomas Becket on Wednesday 5th and Friday 7th July

Dear Parents / Carers,

I am writing to inform you that the school will be impacted by the industrial (strike) action that NEU members are taking on Wed 5th and Fri 7th July. Governors and senior leaders have worked together to establish how many pupils / classes we can still accommodate on site in view of the number of staff who will not be available that day.

I realise that this action is inconvenient for parents & carers and means that children in affected classes will miss a day of directed learning. However, I respect the democratic right of union members to take industrial action and I understand their frustrations with pay and other issues. We have an excellent teaching team here at St Thomas Becket and I know that members who have decided to take part in the industrial action will not have taken this decision lightly but will have done so because they feel that this is the best way to ensure that the profession continues to attract high-calibre candidates and retains those already working in our schools.
