
Dear Parents/Guardians,

Learning for the week beginning 30th October 2023

This week's learning:

• After the half term break we will be teaching the children a new sound every day Monday - Thursday and a new tricky word on Friday. These will be the sounds for the first week back:









Curl around the caterpillar

Down the kangaroo's body curl his tail and lea

- Our tricky word will be 'of'
- In maths we will be learning about 2d shapes: circles, squares, rectangles and triangles. We will be looking at their properties and making sure that we can recognise the shapes in different orientations.
- In RE we will be continuing our new topic of 'welcome'. We will be completing our topic by looking at Jesus' Baptism and how the Holy Spirit came down upon Him in the form of a dove.
- Our story of the week is 'Pete the Cat and his 4 Groovy Buttons'.
