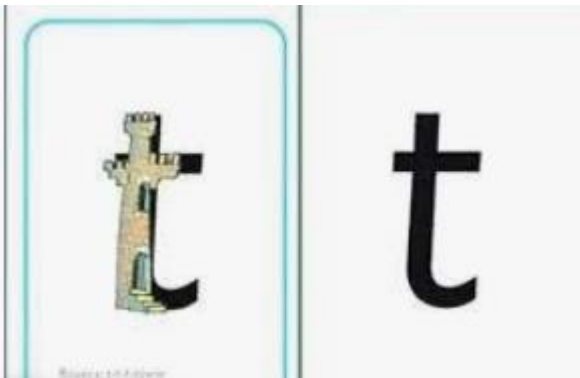
Reception Baseline Assessment

- We will be teaching the children the sound t along with revising our tricky words 'the' and 'no'.



- In maths we will be learning about the number 2 and looking at many different representations of the number such as: coins, dice, fingers. We will also explore the relationship between the number 1 and 2.
