Autumn 2 Week 1's Curriculum:

ENGLISH: we will be reading Ug - Boy Genius of the Stone age linked with our new history topic.

Reading focus: Retrieval of key facts

Writing focus: to retell a myth

Grammar focus: Using conjunctions and adjectives

Spelling focus: 'ou', and 'y' in words

MATHS: We will be learning about measuring length using millimetres, centimetres and metres.

SCIENCE TOPIC: What do rocks tell us about how the earth was formed?

We will be completing our observations on the composition of soil.

R.E TOPIC: Promises

We will continue learning about what happens during baptism.

RSHE:

We will be continuing our Ten Ten program called 'Created and loved by God' learning about 'Jesus my friend.'

HISTORY: Who first lived in Britain?

We will be starting our first history topic, looking at life in Britain from the stone age to the iron age.

FRENCH:

The children will practise greetings and simple phrases using a story.

P.E TOPIC: Invasion games

Next term we will be learning rules, skills and strategies to play tag rugby.

READING: We would like the children to finish reading *Come down, Golden* by *Dianna Noonan*. They should read the chapters and answer any bug questions.
