Next Week's Curriculum:

ENGLISH: we will be reading Ug - Boy Genius of the Stoneage linked with our new history topic.

Reading focus: Reading comprehension

Writing focus: to retell an event in the story

Grammar focus: adjectives and noun phrases

Spelling focus: 'ou', and 'y' in words

MATHS: We will continue to learn how to measure length using millimetres, centimetres and metres. We will also learn how to measure the perimeter of an object.
