Attendance and Staying Open

Well done on achieving a 94% attendance rate over the past few weeks. While still slightly below our usual attendance rate, this is very strong in light of the current challenges we face as a community. We pray our school stays covid -free.

The challenges schools face to remain open was spelt out this week by Dominic Herrington, the national schools commissioner. He has issued a stark warning that, "opening, reopening, closing and partially closing" would "become a way of life" (for schools) and said the need to send bubbles or whole year groups home would become "more prevalent".

Please do note that should a year group be sent home to self-isolate we do have plans to continue children's education remotely, as we did during the summer lockdown.
