We are excited to announce, that as part of our fundraising efforts, we are now working with The Ink Bin.

The Ink Bin was established in 2019 as a fresh and new way to tackle plastic pollution, by pledging to recycle as much of the single-use plastic from ink cartridges as possible.

The Ink Bin accept and recycle ALL home-use cartridges -every cartridge makes a difference! For refillable cartridges (HP and Cannon inkjet) the Ink Bin will give the school some money which will be added to our fundraising totals.

The primary objective of this initiative is, however, to help us be a bit kinder to the environment.

HOW IT WORKS

Please check at home to see if you have any used cartridges, and keep any cartridges you use in the future to donate in our Ink Bin. **There is a designated cartridge drop-off bin located outside the school office entrance on Becket Close.** Feel free to deposit all used printer cartridges here and we'll take care of the rest!
